- Tennessee passed a law this year about Choice Schools
  - o Students can apply to go to another school in their county that they are not zoned for
    - Example, Siegel High School has 200 empty seats and anyone in Rutherford County can apply
  - o The applications are selected through a random lottery process
  - Students must provide their own transportation
- Two School Board seats will be opening after this year one for Lascassas and one for Murfreesboro
  - It would be great to have some Central Magnet School parents on the board
  - Seven people on the board, if four agree then majority wins
- Trying to get a STEM Building for robotics and engineering
  - o This would be renovating the white building in the back of the school
